



Complete F-1 Student Visa Services

Our complete F-1 Student Visa Services include the following three major parts:

- 1. Initial Background Assessment**
- 2. School Application Preparation**
- 3. F-1 Student Visa Interview Preparation**

1. Initial Background Assessment

- Initial contact and establish preferred method of communication and mailing address.
- Client's current and past academic background assessment.
- Client's family and relative information.
- Client's current and past employment information.
- Client's current social, economic and cultural background information.
- Client's intended area of study in the US. Based on this information, the Company will research five to six universities in the US that match your expectations for your review. Or Client can tell the Company which universities Client would like to go and the Company will research Client's preferred choices.
- Financial analysis of adequate funds needed to complete Client's entire study in the US.
- Initial assessment of full funding options based on Client's current academic situation. Such options typically include scholarships, Teaching Assistant (TA) and Research Assistant (RA). TA and RA options are only available at graduate level studies.
- Client's career objectives after completing intended study in the US.

2. School Application Preparation

- Based on the initial choice of five to six universities identified in Initial Background Assessment process, the Company will work with Client to come up with a final list of three schools to file applications. The Company will also identify what majors or programs of study to pursue during Client's study in the US.
- Identify what test(s) to take (TOEFL, GRE or GMAT) and when is the best time to take it if Client has not done so.
- Review school applications and identify what documents are needed. Gather all necessary documents, fill out all application related paperwork and mail out complete application package.
- The Company will establish initial contact with schools' department or program of study for Client. For graduate level students also establish contact with professors of Client's interest and provide their current research areas for Client's review.
- Maintain regular contact with schools to make sure all Client's application materials are received on time and in good order.
- After receiving Client's admission letters, I-20 Forms and funding options from schools, the Company will review the admission offers and suggest which school for Client to attend.

3. F-1 Student Visa Preparation

- Overview of Section 214(b) of the U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Act so Client knows what requirements need to be fulfilled during the visa interview.
- Review nonimmigrant visa Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs).
- The Company will help Client pay the SEVIS fee online and this fee is included in the complete F-1 Student Visa Services fee. The SEVIS fee is not refundable.
- Prepare Form DS-156, DS-157, DS-158 (both Chinese and English) for Client.
- Prepare other documentations and evidence that will establish Client's social, economic, and other ties to China so that Client will depart from the United States and return to China after completing intended study in the US.
- Review required documentation and other items for Client's visa interview.
- Schedule Client's visa interview time and assist Client in making any travel arrangements.
