Follow Up Services

You will find the following follow up services invaluable when you first arrive in the Boston, United States. We are able to offer you these valuable services for free (if you choose our Complete VIP F-1 Student Visa Services) because we are based in Boston. We have the excellent local knowledge drawn upon more than a decade of our own living and working experience in this great city. The Follow UP Services include the following:

- Assist Client in booking airline ticket to Boston or Client's school destination in the US. The Company will compare the ticket price from both Chinese and US airlines and choose the most cost effective options for Client. August and December are busy travel seasons in the US. According to regulations Client must enter the US no earlier than 30 days from the school's start date stated on Form I-20 but not after that date.
- Filling out sample Arrival-Departure Record (Form I-94) and U.S. Customs Declaration Form (Form 6059B) for Client.
- Assist Client in obtaining notarized English translation of Client's Chinese educational documents at normal cost. The Company is also able to assist Client in getting transfer credits for any university level courses taken in China that are comparable to similar university level courses in the US. Typically notarized English translation of Client's Chinese course syllabus and description are needed to obtain transfer credits.
- Assist Client in obtaining low cost and reliable telephone cards to China so Client can stay in touch with family members and relatives easily

The following services are provided to students who are enrolling in a Boston area school in the United States:

- Assist Client in finding a suitable housing option in either school dormitory or local apartments. It is suggested that Client chooses a two to three student shared apartment arrangement to save on monthly housing expenses. The Company will help Client match other Chinese students who also study and live in the Boston area.
- Assist Client in signing apartment rental agreement.
- Airport arrival service and escort Client to selected housing arrangement.
- Guided tour of Client's university and where to report on first day of class.
- Guided tour of major attractions in Boston area, how to get around on four subway lines (Red, Green, Blue and Orange). Most schools in Boston are along these four subway lines so you can commute easily without a car.
- Guided tour information of Boston Chinatown and major food and grocery stores for Chinese people in Chinatown.
- Assist Client in setting up local bank account. Two major banks in the Boston area are Bank of America and Citizens Bank.
- Assist Client in setting up cell phone service, apartment internet access and other related services if Client chooses these services.
- Assist Client in completing school's Certificate of Immunization. All Massachusetts schools require Client to complete this Certificate before Client can be admitted to classes. Client can typically perform the necessary medical tests and be given any additional required immunization shots at school's health services department.
