Admission Requirements for International Students

- A **completed application** for admission with the \$30 undergraduate or \$50 graduate non-refundable fee.
- **International transcripts** - International students are required to send their international transcripts to WES (World Education Services) for a course by course analysis. WES will evaluate the transcript and give us the US equivalent grades and degrees. A transfer student must have their college/university and high school transcripts evaluated. High school transcripts are not required for graduate students. For more information on WES visit their web site at www.wes.org

- **English proficiency or ESL** - All international students are required to take the TOEFL or equivalent as proof of English proficiency. We require a minimum score of 550 on the written test or 213 on the computer-based test. We offer ESL courses at LTU. If a student does not want to take the TOEFL or did not pass the TOEFL, the student has an option to complete ESL courses here. The student should contact the coordinator of the ESL program, Dr. Ben Hoffiz at 248-204-2528. Depending on the program, the student may be allowed to take courses toward their degree along with the ESL courses.
